

ALine moves east

CONSTRUCTION has begun on the Great Eastern Highway between Booran and the Shell Service Station.

ALine East has started survey and clearing works at Booran and will proceed west into the Merredin townsite.

The highway will remain on its existing alignment between Booran and the western end of the curve adjoining the reserve near the rifle range. It will then be aligned to the south along the old rail reserve. Realignment south will enable the intersection at the Merredin-Narembeen Road to be upgraded to include a turning lane.

The information bay will be relocated and streamlined to act as a point of reference only and deter overnight parking and camping.
